

WISE COATINGS AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS



01 Introduction

PolyWise floors are highly durable, resistant to chemicals, and designed to handle heavy traffic. However, regular maintenance is key to preserving their appearance and performance. Follow the guidelines below to care for your PolyWise floors.

02 Daily/Regular Maintenance

2.1 Sweep or Dust Mop

- Use a soft-bristle broom or dust mop to remove dirt, dust, and debris daily. This prevents scratches and keeps the floor looking clean.
- A microfiber dust mop is ideal for capturing fine dust.

2.2 Spot Clean

- Immediately wipe spills or stains with a soft cloth or paper towel to prevent long-term staining.
- Use a mild soap mixed with water for stubborn stains. Simple Green is a good example of a mild soap.

03 Weekly Maintenance

3.1 Wet Mop the Floor

- Use a microfiber mop with water and a pH-neutral cleaner.
- Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning agents that could damage the floor's protective coating.

3.2 Rinse with Clean Water

- After mopping with a cleaning solution, rinse the mop and floor with clean water to avoid residue buildup.
- Use minimal water to prevent pooling.

04 Deep-Cleaning Maintenance

4.1 Heavy Cleaning

- For a more thorough cleaning, use a soft brush or a floor scrubber with very soft bristles.
- Avoid using hard scrubbing brushes that could scratch the surface.

05 Things to Avoid

5.1 No Abrasive Cleaners or Tools

- Avoid scouring pads, steel wool, or harsh scrub brushes that can damage the PolyWise surface.
- Do not use acidic or abrasive chemicals like vinegar or ammonia.

5.2 Avoid Wax or Polish

Do not apply wax or polish to PolyWise floors. The floor is designed to retain its shine without additional products, and wax can make it slippery.

5.3 No Bleach or Ammonia

Avoid harsh chemicals such as bleach or ammonia, which can dull or damage the floor's finish.

06 Long-Term Care

6.1 Prevent Scratches

- Place mats or rugs in high-traffic areas to reduce wear and tear.
- Use furniture pads under chairs, tables, and other heavy objects to avoid scratching the floor.

07 Handling Stains & Spills

7.1 Oil Stains

Clean oil spills quickly with a degreaser. For older oil stains, use a mild scrubbing tool and a PolyWise-safe cleaner.

7.2 Chemical Spills

Clean chemical spills (gasoline, motor oil, etc.) immediately using an appropriate cleaner for PolyWise floors to prevent long-term damage.

08 Additional Tips

- Use Mats at Entrances: Place doormats at entrances to capture dirt and debris before it reaches the floor.
- Temperature Control: Protect PolyWise floors from extreme temperature changes to prolong their lifespan.
